Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Yea Primary School offers a range of items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are beyond what is needed in order to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis. To avoid confusion these have been separated from the Parent Payment Schedule and will be sent out on an event-by-event basis in 2024. This will include Camps (Prep 1,2 / 3 and 4 / 5 and 6), Sporting Events (Swimming, Athletics, Cross Country), Academic Competitions (ICAS, AMT), Instrumental Music Lessons, Excursions, Incursions (Boite, Skipping, ELF Day Guest Speaker, other as may be available and relevant), Graduation, Production and Pool Party tickets and the Yea Primary School Yearbook.

We will always aim to keep the costs as low as possible for these events and to communicate them in a timely manner. The costs per event will change depending on numbers attending as one of the largest costs is transportation (buses).
